_____ Living in a hotel/motel Children and youth are living in motels, hotels, trailer parks, or campgrounds due to the lack of alternative adequate accommodations.

_____ Living in a shelter Children and youth are living in emergency or transitional shelters (or are abandoned in hospitals).

_____ Unsheltered Children and youth have a primary nighttime residence that is a public or private place not designed for or ordinarily used as a regular sleeping accommodation for human beings; or are living in cars, parks, public spaces, abandoned buildings, substandard housing, bus or train stations, or similar settings.
