We are introducing a Safe School Helpline to help prevent such actions. It is designed to assist you in reporting any wrongdoing that impacts our schools, our students or our staff – anonymously, so as to protect your privacy. For example, you may wish to report acts of violence, theft, drug or alcohol use, weapons or sexual harassment.

Just call from a phone 1-800-4-1-VOICE, ext. 359 (that is 1-800-418-6423) to leave you information. Or text 66746 then type TIPS. You may also download the Safe School Helpline App if you have an Apple or Android phone. Your message will not be traced, and you will not be identified. The Safe School Helpline will transcribe and send your message to school officials, so appropriate action can be taken.
